Think Mongolian rock and you might envision sprawling grasslands, icy mountaintops, and blue skies above the sparsely populated country sitting between China and Russia. What you probably won't picture is a six-man band led by a former

Get Ready for Arizona Gives Day Support MIM on April 5

Mark your calendar for Tuesday, April 5, for the fourth annual <u>Arizona Gives Day</u>. During this 24hour statewide fund-raising event, hundreds of nonprofit organizations across the state will unite to promote awareness of their causes and raise funds to create lasting change throughout Arizona. punk singer influenced by Metallica, Led Zeppelin, and Pink Floyd.

That's the eclectic surprise of <u>Hanggai</u>, a crossover Chinese folk group coming to the MIM Music Theater on Thursday, March 31. The band, which performs new arrangements of Mongolian tunes in traditional costume, provides a unique and modern take on Mongolian music.

Hanggai was formed when lead singer llchi, an ethnic Mongolian, grew tired of the punk and rapmetal music he was performing in Beijing and became interested in ancient music forms. Wanting to rediscover his heritage, llchi traveled to Inner Mongolia to learn the traditional art of throat singing, a highly technical style in which the singer produces two or more sounds at the same time.

While in Mongolia, Ilchi and his fellow bandmates began combining traditional Mongolian instruments such as the *morin khuur* and the *tobshuur* with Western guitars, bass, and drums. They became fixtures on Beijing's music scene, performing adaptations of Mongolian folk songs.

Although Hanggai might seem like an unlikely candidate for stardom, the group has become a breakout act that has toured the world. The group even appeared on—and won in—the Chinese reality TV talent show *Sing My Song*.

By balancing traditional and modern, past and present, folk and punk, Hanggai makes an unforgettable statement creating music that can be understood by anyone, anywhere in the world.
