



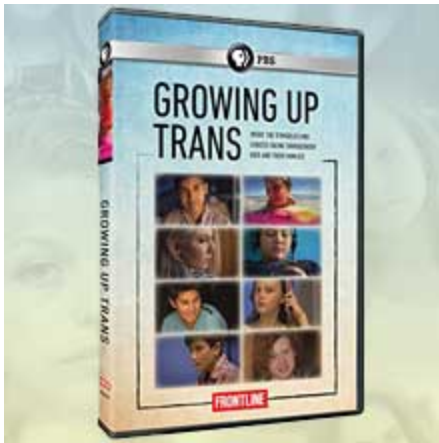
Honoring Our Veterans
