This program is produced by the City of Scottsdale Economic Development Department in partnership with ASU SkySong and Scottsdale Area Chamber of Commerce

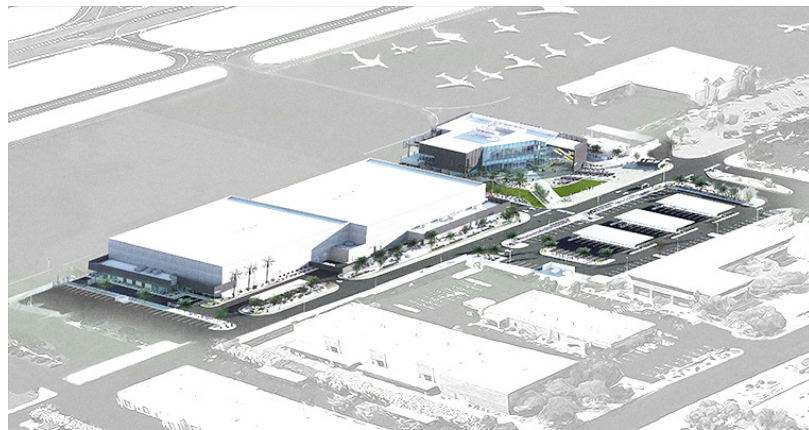
