**Christmas tree recycling drop off locations available through Sunday.** <u>Collection</u> <u>bins</u> will be available at three city parks: <u>Eldorado</u>, <u>Scottsdale Ranch</u> and <u>Thompson Peak</u>. No artificial trees, stands or ornaments will be accepted. We can also pick up your tree curbside during your regular <u>brush and bulk collection week</u>. Place your tree in the brush pile away from bulk items.

**Are your toilets running?** A running toilet can waste over 6,000 gallons of water per month. Test your toilets for leaks by placing a few drops of dark food coloring in the toilet tank – not the bowl – and wait 15 minutes. Don't flush. If you see color in the toilet, you have a leak. Use our free <u>leak detection guide</u>.
