[Why so many Canadian companies are flocking to Arizona](#)

An analysis by the Maricopa Association of Governments in September found 241 Canadian businesses in Arizona, employing more than 22,000 Arizonans. That's nearly double the U.K., which is second highest. While many people think of Mexico as a natural international business partner because of its proximity, only 33 Mexican businesses are in Arizona. Because Canada's market is so small in comparison to the United States, Canadian companies have always looked for ways to tap into American cities, according to Andreas Schotter, assistant professor of international business and global strategy for the Ivey Business School in London.
