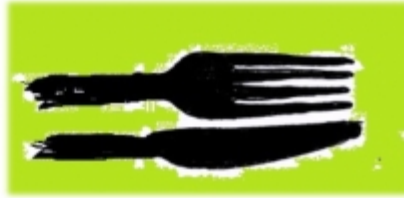

Artists proofs of Frederick J Brown's "*Portraits in Excellence: Suite of Six Musicians*" are on display in the Holland Gallery of Fine Art through September 30. We are open to the community on September 29 from 5:30 - 7 PM for the ALL THAT JAZZ reception.

Frederick J. Brown (1945-2012) was an American artist who explored the relationship between music and painting in portraits of hundreds of jazz and blues artists. His work is represented in the collections of the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York and the Kemper Museum of Contemporary Art in Kansas City, Mo. Influenced by the German Expressionists and Abstract Expressionists like Willem de Kooning, who was his mentor for a time (and who was the subject of one of his most lauded portraits), Mr. Brown occasionally painted in the abstract mode, but he was largely a figurative painter unafraid of grand projects — large-scale canvases, murals, extended series. He was known for placing his subjects, often African-Americans rendered in muted tones, against backgrounds of intense color.

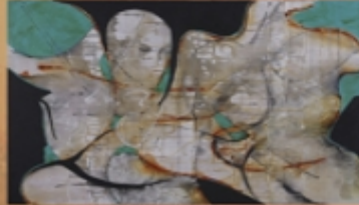

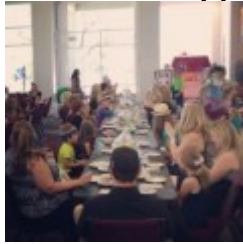
