

Mandela Washington Fellows Visit MIM

In July, for the second consecutive year, a group of Mandela Washington Fellows visited the museum. The <u>Mandela Washington Fellowship for</u> <u>Young African Leaders</u> is the flagship program of President Barack Obama's Young African Leaders Initiative that empowers young people through academic coursework, leadership training, and networking.

The fellowship provides outstanding people between the ages of twenty-five and thirty-five from Sub-Saharan Africa with the opportunity to take part in a six-week academic and leadership institute at a U.S. university in one of three tracks. The fellows who visited MIM attended either the Civic Leadership or Public Management track at Arizona State University (ASU).
