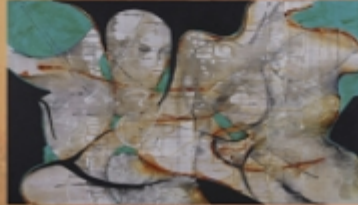
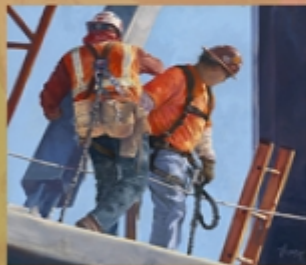

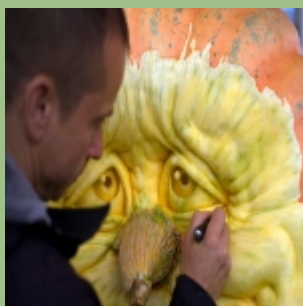
#11. Volunteer at the 2nd Annual Enchanted Pumpkin Garden
