Indian School Park Playground Construction

We have a new project underway, which will result in two new playgrounds at Indian School Park. This was the City's oldest playground, built in 1995.

The new playground will have a play area for 3 - 5 year olds and another area for 6 - 12 year olds. The playground will also have woodchips instead of sand, making it totally accessible to all children. The project should be complete by early December.
