

Hear Them Ring

Celebrate handbells and more on December 17 and 18

Chimes and jingles will fill the halls at MIM as we celebrate the season with instruments that ring on Saturday, <u>December 17</u>, and Sunday, <u>December 18</u>, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. See live performances featuring handbells, handpans, and more. Enjoy heartwarming seasonal songs played by Bells of Paradise, a five-octave, fifteen-member handbell-and-chime choir. And join Sylvain Paslier and Jill Paslier for a performance of peaceful melodies on the handpan, a new-age instrument invented and built by the Swiss company PANArt Hangbau in 2001.

Guests can explore the world of Brazilian music by jamming out at a samba workshop highlighting drumming, singing, and <u>agogo bells</u>. They can also try their hand at MIM's set of handbells and create their own special handmade bell made with recycled materials to put a little "jingle" in their day.

The weekend will feature special holiday treats at <u>Café Allegro</u>. And the <u>Museum Store</u> will spotlight an assortment of beautiful <u>bells</u> from around the world, such as <u>bicycle bells</u> and dinner bells from Japan and copper bells from India, as well as <u>jingle-bell bands</u> for children.


