***Catherine Jones, A Pistol Packing Momma (Cave Creek Character Exhibit)***

Catherine Jones was a deputy game warden in the 1920s. She homesteaded the 1280 acre Cahava Ranch. She loved to drive. She was an artist, a poetess, and the unofficial “Queen of Cave Creek” for almost half a century. Discover how Catherine earned her nickname and participate in interesting activities of life in Cave Creek in the '20s.

In 1958, Beverly Metcalfe Brooks left behind Illinois to become one of the last paying guests at a dude ranch. She came looking for adventure---and found love and a new life in a little Arizona town

called Cave Creek. In her 58 years as a resident of Cave Creek, Bev has known the most vaunted of names in our town's past: Catherine Jones, Hube and Patsy Yates, George Mileham, Honky-Tonk Jack, Harold Gavagan, Frank and Hazel Wright---the list goes on. And she herself is an influential part of the Creek's history, having been a founding member of the famed "Mother's Club". Enjoy a rare opportunity to hear this sassy, opinionated Cave Creek treasure share stories about some of Cave Creek's greatest characters and Cave Creek's growth from a dusty Calvary re-mounting station in the 1870's to the town we all live in today.
