Introducing the Encore Gallery

New space offers more interactive activities for children

Many of us have picked up and played an instrument at some point in our lives. Maybe it was piano lessons in elementary school or the violin for a few years as a teen. But what about playing a djembe from West Africa? Or a concertina from Germany?


Last month MIM opened the Encore Gallery, a new space that allows guests to interact with instruments like these as well as others from all over the world, to school and youth tours. The gallery was designed with young children in mind to offer developmentally appropriate activities for early childhood learning.

Besides offering musical instruments to play, the space features many other important aspects for children including natural light, object labels mounted lower to read, open space, and materials for dramatic play such as scarves.

In 2016, we experienced a significant increase in school and youth <u>tours</u>, with 58,000 participants visiting MIM. Our goal is to reach 100,000 participants by 2020 and the Encore Gallery will help facilitate that growing number by offering additional space for children and teachers to discover music through hands-on activities.

The Encore Gallery, built with the help of a \$150,000 grant from Virginia G. Piper Charitable Trust, is next to the <u>Experience Gallery</u>, another interactive space where guests can play global instruments. While the Encore Gallery is currently dedicated to prekindergarten–2nd grade school tours, it may also be opened to the public on busy days and for special events.

MIM Collaborates with Museo de la Música Mexicana

Partnership highlights global music with instruments and artifacts from MIM

In December 2016, <u>Museo de la Música Mexicana</u> in Puebla, Mexico, opened with several instruments and artifacts from MIM's permanent collection as part of a newly formed partnership between the two museums.

The exhibits showcase world music from Africa, Latin America, and Asia. The variety of artifacts, instruments, videos, and photos from MIM are regionally focused, offering a wider glimpse into the cultures and music of those areas, while also celebrating the universality of music.

The space also includes video monitors, projectors displaying MIM's orientation film, and small identifiers at each display that trigger sound in an encased iPod that guests carry with them, along with headsets. MIM's team worked closely with the staff at Museo de la Música Mexicana to ensure the overall experience was similar to what guests have at MIM.

The Peoria Arts & Cultural Festival celebrates the thriving art and cultural environment in Peoria Unified School District schools, and all proceeds benefit the Peoria Education Foundation, which directly supports these schools. Students from Peoria Unified School District will be showcasing their artwork and performing in dance routines, theater acts, and choir and band shows throughout the day. The event is located at Peoria and Grand Avenues at the following venues: Osuna Park, Peoria Center for the Performing Arts, and the Peoria Community Center. The new museum features indigenous Mexican music displayed chronologically throughout Mexican history. In the months ahead, MIM will be identifying instruments and artifacts from Museo de la Música Mexicana that will be highlighted within our own Geographic Galleries.
