Acoustic Alchemy

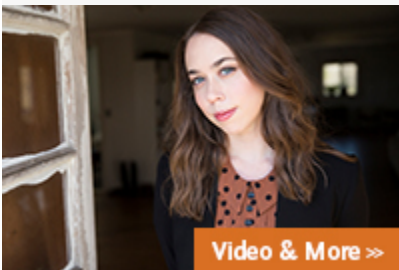
