Scottsdale Economic Development focuses on recruiting talent in-state and beyond

Scottsdale's Economic Development team has played a direct role in creating or retaining more than 1,000 new jobs with an average wage of \$62,744 in FY 2016/17. Companies such as Datashield (a cybersecurity firm), ChargePoint Inc. (an electric vehicle charger company) and Deskhub (a co-working space) are among the many businesses to have added jobs in Scottsdale in the past year.

Twice a year, the Arizona Commerce Authority's (ACA) Arizona Innovation Challenge (AIC) awards \$1.5 million to the most innovative companies looking to commercialize new technology to create sustainable and growing businesses in the State of Arizona.
