The areas all along Cave Creek Wash are abundant in desert flora and fauna and steeped in history. P.A. Seitts Preserve at Go John Canyon is no exception. The preserve not only holds a sensitive riparian habitat it is also rich in archaeology, mining and ranching history. Along

the trail, hikers can get a feel for what desert life might have been like in earlier days and even visit the site of Cave Creek's first cemetery.
