Funding for Scottsdale transportation projects headed to the ballot. Scottsdale voters will <u>consider a sales tax increase</u> this November to fund transportation improvements under a plan adopted by the City Council May 1. The ballot proposal would increase the city's sales tax rate by one-tenth of 1 percent for a period of 10 years. The rate increase, which amounts to an additional ten cents for every \$100 retail purchase in Scottsdale, is expected to raise an additional \$10 million a year for transportation projects and operations and related costs.
