## 2 new exhibitions opening July 28!

***Indwelling*** is a solo exhibition of Yuri Kobayashi, a contemporary artist who combines traditional woodworking practices and refined Japanese aesthetics to create sculptures that reflect her identity, experiences and thoughts. In the five artworks in this exhibition, Kobayashi strives to embody the surprise and wonder found in the impalpable and often illogical world in which we live.

***A Bigger Plan*** is a two-part solo exhibition of Euan MacDonald, a Los Angeles-based artist whose work spans a wide range of artistic disciplines, from video to painting. This exhibition is divided into 2 parts. "Side B" (July 28–Sept. 1) marks the first survey of MacDonald's videos, while "Side A" (Sept. 15–Dec. 1) features an immersive video installation that layers pre-psychedelic patterning from the end pages of 18th, 19th and early 20th century books from the open stacks of ASU Hayden Library.
