MARLENE SABATINA:

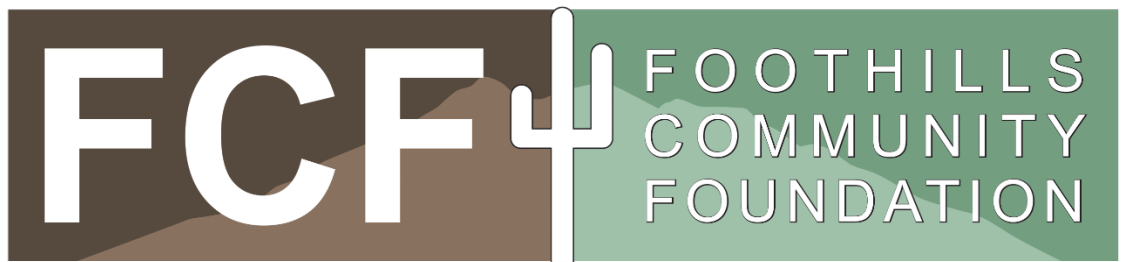
